## Poetry Enrichment Activities

<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Brochure</b> Create a brochure all about poetry. Include information about the types of poems, the features of poems (such as rhyme scheme, mood, stanza, etc.), and some writers of poetry. Must have a title, mention at least 15 facts, be colorful, and be neat.	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Poetry Games</b> Design a simple card game or board game about poetry. Be sure to write down the rules of your game. If making a board game, be sure to make it colorful. Neatness is a must.	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Haiku Collection</b> Choose a topic or theme (sports, family, school, friendship, etc.). Then, write 5 haikus about the topic/theme you picked out. Your poems must be written neatly and follow the 5-7-5 syllable pattern. Include at least one picture.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>What's it Worth?</b> Using the word calculator below, calculate the value of a poem we read or studied in class. Add up the value of each word in the poem. Be sure to show your work. Box or circle the poem's total. Be neat!	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Free Choice</b> Do you have your own idea that you would like to complete? Simply fill out the proposal form on the back. Then, have your teacher review it and sign it. Do not start on this choice until your teacher has signed the proposal form!	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Poetry Graph</b> Review the many poems studied in class. After reviewing the poems, make a pie or bar graph showing the types of poems read, the number of stanzas of each poem, or something else entirely. Must have a title, be in color, be accurate, be neat, include percentages, and include a key.
<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Anthology</b> For this task, you will create an anthology, or collection, of all of your favorite poems. These can be poems we read in class or favorites you have read on your own. Must include 6-8 poems, include a title, be neat, and include the author with each poem.	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Book Spine Poetry</b> View examples of book spine poetry. Afterward, create your own! You must create at least 3 poems using this method. Instead of taking pictures, simply write down each poem on a piece of paper. Neatness is a must. You will need to be creative, but the poem must make sense.	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Crossword Puzzle</b> On your own paper, create a crossword puzzle using <u>all</u> of the terms we have studied while learning about poetry. Include an answer key with your puzzle. Be neat and include a title.
